

## **AnchorPoint Christian School Lunch Program 101 For New Families!**

Lunch is served every school day. Following is a brief description of "how things work" for your student at school in regards to the school meals program:

✓ Every student has food service account upon enrollment even if they do not purchase school meals. Their account number is their School Student ID number.

✓ Free or Reduced-priced meals are available for those who qualify based upon income guidelines set by the Federal Government. Applications can be filled out online at **www.lunchapp.com**. Paper applications can be printed from the school website.

✓ Lunch is \$2.75. Lunch costs \$.40 for reduced priced students. Milk is included with all reimbursable meals. Milk can be purchased separately for \$.50.

✓ Any amount of money can be deposited to student accounts. We discourage cash deposits because cash can be lost between home and the school cafeteria! Payment options for parents include:

1. **Make a deposit to student accounts online at [www.sendmoneytoschool.com](http://www.sendmoneytoschool.com) with an e-Check or a debit or credit card.** You can make deposits online to all your students in one transaction.
2. **Send a check to school with one of your children.** Please make sure the student's name is on the memo line of the check.
  - **CASH CAN BE LOST AND IS DIFFICULT TO TRACK** – Either write a check to send to school or make deposits online as suggested above.
3. Send a check via regular mail to: Kelloggsville Public Schools, Food Service Department, 23 Jean Street SW, Wyoming, MI 49548.

✓ Nutrition Service staff members enter all deposits into the computer on the day the check or cash is received.

✓ Parents may make deposits and view student balances 24/7 at the [www.sendmoneytoschool.com](http://www.sendmoneytoschool.com) website.

✓ **Parents are responsible for making sure their children have money on their account or cash in the line to purchase meals!!**

If an account balance falls below \$0, the student will continue to receive and be charged for a hot lunch for a few days. Notices and/or emails will be sent home during that time requesting that a deposit be made. If a deposit is not made in a timely manner, the student will be given a cold lunch consisting of a sandwich, apple and milk.
