### **A look at our week**

**In Bible** this week we will reflect on the stories of Passion Week. I use the story of Benjamin's Box. The Bible memory verse is coming home today. This week in **Math** the Youngers will begin learning about fractions. We will learn that a fraction needs to be made up of equal parts. The Olders will continue to work with fractions. They will compare fractions and practice with fraction stories. In **literacy work** each group of readers will begin a new book. Many of the groups will start a chapter book. When reading chapter books the reader learns how to recall previous events in order to keep the story going in his head. In **Science** your child will begin working on the final project for the animal unit. They will be reporting on an animal. The project will include a picture of the animal, its habitat, life cycle and 4 facts about it.
