## CHILD CARE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

For many families, the cost of safe, quality child care can affect the family budget. The Child Development and Care (CDC) Program may offer payment for child care services for some families when the parent is not able to provide child care for approved reasons. #### ILLNESS PROCEDURE

AnchorPoint Christian is committed to providing a safe and healthy place for each child. If your child becomes ill at school, he/she will be isolated in comfort with supervision, and you will be called to pick up your child as soon as possible.

A child should remain at home on any school day that he/she has:

- Fever of 100 degrees or higher
- Diarrhea
- Been vomiting two or more times in a 24-hour period
- A rash
- Evidence of a bad cold or cough, including nasal discharge that is green or yellow
- Eyes that are pink, burning, itching, or producing discharge

Parents/Guardians should call the school office prior to 8:30 AM on days their children are absent. Give the child's name, teacher's name, and child's symptoms. AnchorPoint is required to report any and all types of illness to the Kent County Health Department.
