Reading: Students will begin an author's study of Beverly Cleary by reading a whole class novel called *Mouse and the Motorcycle*. We will focus on vocabulary, asking good questions and author's craft while we read this week.

Writing: Students will write a Bio poem and then learn how to write a business letter to get information about a state for their state reports.
