Devotions: Gerrit on 4/19

Reading: Students will continue an author's study of Beverly Cleary by reading The Mouse and the Motorcycle. We will focus on vocabulary, asking good questions, and noticing how the author uses adjectives to describe things in her book.

Writing: Students will design letterhead for their business letter and learn how to address an envelope. Then we begin work on a power paragraph.

Math: 3rd: Focus is on reviewing for a test on fractions and then beginning a unit on extended multiplication and division.

4th: Focus is on learning to multiply fractions and review for our test next week Monday.

Science: Dr. Vibrato will talk about how to make sounds loud or soft, how sound interacts with other materials and how we hear.

Bible: We will read about Saul and the witch of Endor, David destroying the Amelkites and the deaths of Saul and Jonathan. We will review for a test on Monday.
