### PEEK INTO OUR CLASSROOM

**Devotions:** Ari on 2/15; Alex on 2/22

**Reading:** This week we will begin a unit on fairytales. Students will practice compare and contrast with a Cinderella story and learn how cause and effect is used in a fairytale.

**Writing:** Students will begin work on their rough drafts of their animal reports. They will turn their questions into topic sentences and use their research to write supporting sentences.
