### HOMEWORK CORNER

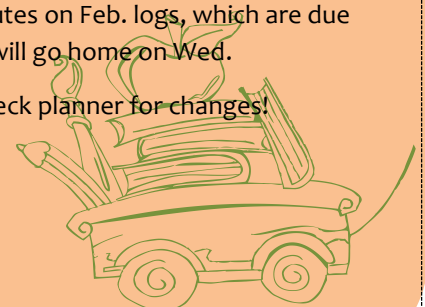
