### PEEK INTO OUR CLASSROOM

**Devotions:** Christian on 3/15; Owen on 3/22

**Reading:** We are each continuing to read an individual biography they chose. This week they will write a letter to a classmate about the person they are reading about. Then they will write a second letter in reply to his/her peer letter.

**Writing:** Students will continue typing their final drafts of their mystery stories as well as an author page. They will also do one final edit of typed drafts and then consider where to place illustrations.

**Math: 3<sup>rd</sup>:** Focus is on exploring ratios of geometric figures, ratios, and extended facts. They will have a test on this unit on Friday.

**4<sup>th</sup>:** Focus is on probabilities, exploring fractional parts, adding & subtracting fractions, and finding many names for fractions.

**Social Studies:** Students will learn about products made in the South, begin working on South culture projects and prepare for a quiz on NE/South states and capitals.

**Bible:** Focus is on anointing a new king, David & Goliath, and Saul's jealousy.
