Bible: New Bible memory is I Samuel 15:22 & 16:7b which is due Wed., March 29th.

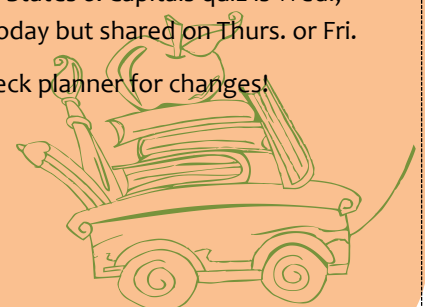
3rd Math: HL 7.9 & 8.1 are due Wed.; HL 8.2 due on Thurs.
