PEEK INTO OUR CLASSROOM

Reading: Students will work on a project related to our reading of *The Mouse and the Motorcycle* as well as talk about author's craft.

Math: 3rd: Focus is on division with remainders, lattice multiplication, exploring arrays, and products of 2-digit numbers.

Bible: Psalm 24 is due Wed., May 24th.

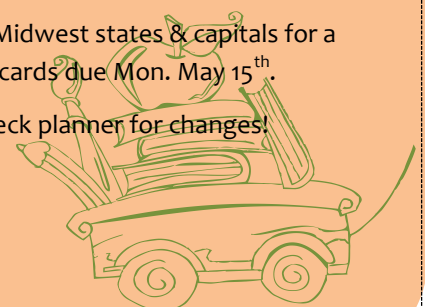
3rd **Math:** HL 9.7 & 9.8 due Wed.; HL 9.9 due Thurs.
