SKILL CORNER—DIVISION CEREAL ARRAYS

Play a game of Division Cereal Arrays with your child. Have your child take out a handful of cheerios or another type of cereal that doesn't roll. © Roll a dice. Have them divide their group of cereal into that many groups. If there are leftovers, they get to keep those as their score. Have them write the problem out on a piece of paper. (Ex: 22 cheerios/5 = 4 R2). Then it would be your turn and you would only use the remaining 20 cereal. Keep going until the original handful of cereal is used up. The player with the most wins!
