### PEEK INTO OUR CLASSROOM

**Reading:** We will continue to read *Frindle* as we focus on how to answer questions, find the main idea, and write predictions using vocabulary from the chapter.

**Writing:** Students will finish their personal narratives and share them.

**Bible:** Our new unit focuses on what and why God created the world. This week we will learn about days 1-3 of creation.

**Math:** 3<sup>rd</sup>: Focus is on multi-digit addition/subtraction problems, number stories with several addends, and reviewing for a test on Thurs.
