Reading: This week we will finish reading *Frindle*. Students will practice some of the comprehension skills we learned with the last few chapters as well as write a letter to a character.

Writing: We will make covers for our important person narratives. Then begin learning about the parts of speech, starting with nouns.

Bible: Focus is on Creation days 1-5. We will also discuss our new Bible memory, Gen. 1:27-28.
