### PEEK INTO OUR CLASSROOM

**Reading:** Students began to create a list of books they are reading in a Reader's Notebook last week. Now, we will discuss how to write responses to our reading in the form of a letter.

**Writing:** Our summer shorts (stories) have been hung up in the hall! Now we will begin exploring how to develop ideas to write about as we use our writer's notebooks. This week, students will focus on unforgettable stories and fierce wanderings.

**Bible:** We will review what we have learned about Ephesians through a game and by making a little book. Then they will have their first Bible test on next Mon.

**Math:** 3<sup>rd</sup>: Focus is on finding differences & using a calculator.

**Math** 4<sup>th</sup>: Focus is on using compasses to make hexagon & triangle constructions, and a 6-pointed design. We will review what we have learned for a test on Thurs.

**Social Studies:** We will look at Michigan's vegetation, state symbols, climate, and begin to explore the human characteristics.
