HOMEWORK CORNER

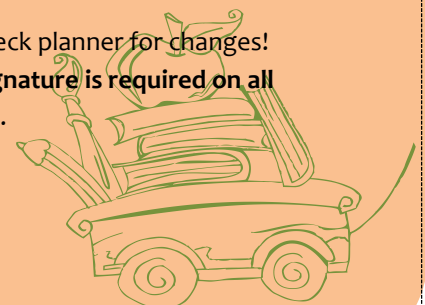
3rd Math: HL 1.9 & 1.10 due on Wed.; HL 1.11 due on Thurs.; Unit 1 test on Thurs.
