PEEK INTO OUR CLASSROOM

Reading: Students are learning how to choose good fit books as they pick a book from our classroom library to read. They will also practice reading to self and how to think about what they read by recording what they recall from a story. We are learning to see what good readers look like.

Writing: Students need to decorate their notebook covers to make the book a special place to record their own writing. We are also writing a summer short story, so watch for our summer laundry to be hung out to dry!

Math: 3rd: Focus is on number sequence, grids, and place value.

4th: Focus is on exploring the Student Reference Book; points, lines, & segments; creating angles, triangles, & quadrangles.

Social studies: Our focus is to learn about where we are located in God's world and its landforms.

Bible: We are learning how Paul encourages us to work as a team as part of God's family in his letter to the Ephesians.
